African Romance (B2.451 D) / African Romance - Fair Trade with Diamonds

Crime, exploitation, expulsion, destruction of the environment and financing wars in the countries of the third world, which are rich in gold, silver and gems, tarnish the image of the coveted precious stones. African Romance™ works to protect the natural resources of South Africa, fair trade and improved working conditions for the populace. All diamonds come from their own mines. In addition, the cut jewelry stones of the South African diamond company are provided with a "fingerprint", with which every diamond can be traced back from retailer to its origin, and each diamond is checked by internationally renowned certification laboratories.

The jewelry collections from African Romance reflect the beauty of the continent. For example, the "African Earth Collection" is inspired by the wide expanses of the Serengeti, the eternally shifting sand dunes of the Sahara and the majestic Mt. Kilimanjaro, which is expressed in unique patterns. The "African Heritage Collection" was created based on an ancient African tradition to adorn oneself with gold and diamonds. The "African Embrace Collection" was created as a tribute to love; in it, each large diamond is embraced by several smaller, tender ones.

Al Coro (B1.214 A) / Jewelry Pieces Made of Rose Quartz and Aquamarine

Al Coro enchants the spring with jewelry pieces made of rose quartz and aquamarine. The rosé gold creations in connection with rose quartz seem like tender rosebuds. A cabochon cut brings out the full natural radiance of the precious stone. Clear diamonds hem the edge of the rose quartz blossoms like dew drops. The highlight of the jewelry set is a ring, which encloses a rose quartz with a finely curved bow structure. The aquamarine jewels of another collections seem like sparkling raindrops. The drop-shaped faceting makes the gems radiate in a soft blue shade. White gold and diamonds make the jewelry set complete, which is composed of necklace, ring and earrings.

Aristo Vollmer GmbH (A1.502 E) / ARISTO B WATCH "SEXTANT": Matured for 65 Years

Fashion changes continuously. There is insufficient time for development work. Only few watch models achieve their optimum maturity.

The ARISTO "SEXTANT" in 44 mm casing has taken the luxury to reach the height of its career after a time to maturity of 65 years. Now, this replica of a B watch (air force observation watch) has been nominated for the selection of the "Watch of the Year 2008". The inner works of the ARISTO B Watch "SEXTANT" would also satisfy space pioneers. The reason is that they could choose between the automatic works ETA 2824-2 or the ETA 2801 manual wind - both at a price of 495 euros. As a result, the readers of "Welt am Sonntag" and the magazine "Armbanduhren" (Heel Publishing Company) have two reasons to vote the ARISTO B WATCH "SEXTANT" as the "Watch of the Year".

Beneq Oy (A2.606 E Technology) / Beneq Oy of Finland

Beneq Oy of Finland is manufacturer of industrial equipment for Atomic Layer Deposition (ALD) and nHALO® atmospheric flame spray technology, processing different kinds of nanoparticle materials. The equipment is designed to address markets in need of functional (e.g., protective and barrier) and decorative (interference colors) coatings nSILVER® is the novel coating method developed by Beneq. nSILVER® providing superior protection against silver tarnishing. This is achieved by a transparent, uniform and pin-hole free coating over the entire silver object.

Michael Berger (C2.217 B Concepts Forum) / Striking Ring Creations

Michael Berger shows daring plays of shape: for example, a striking ring creation in blank, on which two pearls seem to balance at the top as culmination.

Breil Milano (A1.232/335, Aisle B/C) / Extravagant Watches

Breil Milano combines Italian design and Swiss watches and is one of the globally leading manufacturers of luxury watches. Diver watches with retro influences, asymmetric stainless steel casings in urban style as well as wood or rubber inserts for aficionados of extravagant watches are part of the new collection. Refined jewelry is also being exhibited. "Dew drops" made of a mixture of red gold, sterling silver and stainless steel are the shining points on various jewelry pieces; each one is unique. The popular Brazilian tradition of wish bands has also been included and converted into cotton bands with high-quality precious metal. The jewelry pieces are in part the work of the company boss Marcello Binda, whose grandfather and company founder once threw a watch down from the Eiffel Tower to prove its sturdiness.

Bunz (B1.105/206 A/B) / New Premium Collection

Bunz is betting on classic, timeless jewels in its new premium collection. The combination of many-faceted color stones, polished rosé gold and diamonds are full of excitement but still harmonious.

Cerruti 1881 (A1.328/531 C/E)

Flower patterns, fanciful shapes, colors and bright hues: Cerruti 1881 is reflecting the beauty of nature in its jewelry collection "Ornaments". Romantic blossom and leaf shapes intertwine in the jewelry line "Giardino", which is set with stones made of white zirconium. Water in its sparkling purity is expressed in the "Goccia" line. Drop-shaped zirconium is enclosed by white zirconium pavée.

Charriol (A1.214/315 B/C) / "Circle of love" and "Bamboo" Collections

Charriol is extolling a jewelry celebration of love and friendship with its two collections "Circle of love" and "Bamboo". The latter is an exotic wire jewelry line, inspired by the sensory stimuli of Asia. Delicate interwoven stainless steel wires join to form armlets and rings, which are enclosed by the stylized shape of a bamboo blossom. The two bracelet and ring combinations in black made of PVD-coated stainless steel product a glamorous effect. Coralie Charriol has designed a jewelry ensemble with "Circle of love", which will enchant not only romantics. Romantic, small silver hearts made of stainless steel wire nestle together. These gentle circles of love symbolize the preciousness of eternal love.

Ducati Corse (A1.232/335 B/C) / Ducati Corse Presents Its First Watch Collection

At the booth of BINDA Deutschland GmbH, Ducati, known as Italian motorcycle manufacturer, is presenting the world premiere of its first watch collection in line with the idea that sport molds lifestyle decisively. The design inspired by motorsports will make not only the hearts of enthusiastic men motorcycle fans beat faster.

"edc by esprit" (A1.328/531 C/E)/"edc by esprit" Presented by EganaGoldpfeil

"edc by Esprit" as an international label of young lifestyles reflects the extremely fast and exciting feeling of life of a whole generation. For example, the label converts new music trends into fashion and was sponsor of MTV Europe Music Awards in 2007. Now EganaGoldpfeil is raising curtain for the world premiere of the new edc jewelry collection for the age group 14 to 24 and promises a fulminant start.

Elysee (A1.216/317 B/C)

The newest chronographs of the "Keeping Passion Alive" campaign by Elysee have fascinating technology and a classic, pure retro design. The watch manufacturer is starting off with a strong advertising campaign and the German race driver legend Alexander Garf Berghe from Trips. The goal is to keep passion for life with the first German Ferrari driver from the 50s and 60s and the quartz watches in retro style. Elysee is going to launch the automatic watches "Made in Germany" in the fall.

Levis is known for jeans. Under the wings of Elysee Uhren, the Levis Group is expanding its range of products with sporty watches with a special casing shapes and fashionable designed dial faces starting in November. A pocket watch with digital display and an unusual look supplements the Levis trendy outfit perfectly. The Levis logo, which has remained unchanged for decades, is always the focus of the collection.

Ricarda Enderweit (C2.326 No. 16) / Pure Nature

Natural colors and organic shapes give the jewelry pieces from Ricarda Enderweit a wondrous life of their own. It seems as if the delicate pearls grow out of the silver blossom on the ring finger.

European Watch Group (A1.513 Aisle E)

Retailers can check an offer unequalled till now at the trade fair booth of the European Watch Group. Ten manufacturers of brand watches have joined to create this common marketing platform. Riedenschild, Thunderbirds, LACO, Saro-Gem, Bombadier, Vulcain, Germano, Poljot, Thomas Ninchritz and Kudoko are offering chronographs at prices between 300 and 30,000 euros via a joint catalogue and distribution system for all 10 companies.

Fabergé (B1.110 A) / Watch and Matching Cufflinks

Fabergé has created a watch using enamel technology for men with good perspectives. The model with the gold dial face has been fire-enamelled by hand and kept in a radiating blue shade. The mechanical automatic works with second display is based on a work by Frédéric Piguet. As accessory, Faberge has matching cufflinks in blue, guilloched by hand and adorned with diamonds.

Elgin Fischer (C2.224 B Concepts Forum) / Colorful Fired-Enamel

Elgin Fischer is presenting colorful fired-enamel adorned in expressive uni-colored gold and silver pendants, rings and pins, such as the colorful "Bubbles" for ears.

Fossil Group (A1.332/339)

Fossil is continuing the Twist collection as well as its successful wood line this season. The automatic watchworks of the new "Twist" men's model can even be observed ticking via a small window on the dial face. On the other hand, nature lovers are fond of the round ebony and shining stainless steel elements of the wood watches. A new ladies' model radiates in white, silver and mother of pearl, which has a chronograph function. In jewelry, Fossil is betting on the methods of ion-plating, which lets stainless steel jewelry radiation in many nuances for an especially long time. The men's necklace made of stainless steel and set in refined onyx and PU is precisely the right thing for fans of fast cars. The tire tracks of a racing car can be detected in the black PU.

Gold melts with delicious chocolate colors in the new collection of the US star designer Michael Kors. The charm watch was inspired by jewelry in a vintage look. A watch, eight talers in horn and gold look as two glass stones set in gold swing from a golden chain bracelet. A gorgeous stainless steel watch is set all-around with zirconium stones, on the other hand.

Fossil Group is presenting a collection from DKNY for the first time. The modern, plain watches are a tribute to New York. The cut, brown-color topaz, which is set with a watch, radiate like street lamps in the Big Apple. The golden and brown cross-pieces of another model are intertwined as if in an embrace.

The color white as well as colorful stones are also found in the chronographs from Michele Watches. The luxury brand has succeeded in making an artwork with the Turbina Butterfly. The stainless steel casing of the chronograph is coated with gold and adorned blue, pink and mandarin colored sapphires, red hodolites, green tsavorites and clear diamonds.

Frey Wille (B1.212 B)

The new "Joy of Life" jewelry pieces of the Frey Wille artists express pure joy of life. The designs "Paradise Daylight" and "Paradise Moonlight" are colorful with flower, plants, the moon or the gentle light rays of the sun. Gentle colors such as light blue, yellow, pink or green can be found in the "Heavenly Joy bicolor" pendants and ear studs.

Furrer-Jacot (B1.218 B) / Furrer-Jacot Presents Wedding Rings in Bicolor Design

Various precious metals in the bicolor design of the refined wedding rings melt together like souls, at times minimalist, at times opulent. On the occasion of the anniversary "150 Years Furrer-Jacot", the wedding couple can chose from between a diamond in the inner side or a hand-colored sketch of the ring couple as a gift. There is also a series of new solitaire rings for the anniversary.

Gardé Uhren und Feinmechanik Ruhla GmbH (A1.516 E) / "Wilduhr" (Game Clock)

A "Wilduhr" from Gardé serves not only for measuring the time; it also saves hunters long waiting times for game. The plastic housing, resistant against kicks and bites, can be set up everywhere and records the time on a 24-hour display when wild animals move at this place and knock it over.

August Gerstner (B1.217 B Platinum Forum) / Wedding Ring Collection with Gentle Dune Pattern and Smooth Wave Shapes

Gentle dune pattern and smooth wave shapes characterize the new wedding ring collection from August Gerstner, symbol for shared flow of life. A special "softline" inner curve provides wearers with the corresponding life-long wearing comfort.

Goldsmith Studio Christine Grossmann (B2.507 A) / Guardian Angel Wings: The Trend with Wings

Everyone needs a guardian angel. Many people agree with this and now have the chance to give shape to their thoughts. The Goldsmith Studio Christine Grossmann is presenting her new jewelry collection Guardian Angel Wings in Munich at inhorgenta 2008.

The central component is a stylized guardian angel wing, which is clearly set apart with its timeless, clear and airy design from those available on the market till now, often with kitschy features.

Günster von Schumann, Goldsmith (C2.237, Aisle B) / Tribute to TITANIUM

Among other things, Dietmar Günster-von Schumann is presenting tissue balls made of titanium with diameters of 8 to 22 mm within the framework of his collection "NATURE IN DESIGN". In addition to naturally colored and thermally dyed jewelry pieces made of pure titanium, there are bicolor combinations made of:

TITANIUM 900/000 yellow gold

TITANIUM 585/000 red gold

TITANIUM 950/000 palladium

TITANIUM is convincing thanks to its lightness and wearing comfort, is anti-allergic, thermally colorable (resistant) and indestructible. The metal often used in medical technology and airplane construction only has a shadowy existence in the jewelry industry. Günster-von Schumann believes that this is not justified, because - among other things - very special color effects can be achieved and large pieces are very light.

Hans-Dieter Haag Gem Polisher (C1.308/409)

A new event at Inhorgenta is as unique as a precious stone. Visitors have the chance to take a seat at a grinding machine at the booth of Hans-Dieter Haag and to give a gem a unique shine under the guidance of expert instructions. The company has produced two portable machines, which can be disassembled, for this presentation and will demonstrate grinding of gems all day on all trade fair days in the new Precious Stone Hall C1. Visitors can practice beveling and polishing on pre-shaped quartz, and - whoever wants to - can take the self-cut stone home as a souvenir.

Werner Häring (B1.310 C) / Movable Ring

His ring should be more than mere decoration, and consequently Werner Häring created a movable model that is in interplay with its wearer. Inspired by the spiral shape as it occurs thousands of times in nature, he rotates several diamonds through an inset ball bearing on his white gold ring. A new jewelry makeup set also represents an extraordinary accessory; the finger ring is a powder box, and the lipstick is made of red gold and set with diamonds.

Henrich & Denzel (B1.211 B Platinum Forum) / New Wedding Ring Collection

Jewelry from Henrich & Denzel binds. The new wedding ring collection Due Più deals with the topic of belonging together. A solitaire supplements the traditional wedding rings for ladies and men. The longing for belonging and harmony is reflected in the two pendants of the graceful creation Duetto.

Herbstrith (B1.109 A) / Ornate Curbchain Necklace

Herbstrith is presenting an ornate curbchain necklace "La Vie en Rose" made of sparkling 18 carat rosé gold at inhorgenta 2008. Radiating rodolith is combined with a warm gold hue in this jewel. 106 diamonds at the jewelry closure sparkle with the color of a blossoming rose for your attention - the quintessence of classic elegance.

Katja Hunold (C2.436)

The young designer Katja Hunold is presenting jewelry good enough to eat. Although her two new jewelry lines look like whipped cream, they are really made of 925 silver, and the chocolates are made of rubber. The cream rings extend the "sweet jewelry" and are composed of 925 silver with a freshwater pearl or various colored gems. The sweet delicacies and their precious objects have two things in common for the jewelry designer. Both are luxury goods for savoring and create a lot of happiness for someone you are fond of. Then why not give both together to your favorite person for indulging?

Kienzle AG (A1.402/503) / Kienzle with "Made in Germany" Collection

Kienzle is presenting the first model of the Kienzle 1822 "Made in Germany" collection and is betting on classic design with it, which fits every situation. The ROTARY series "Revelation" is distinguished by two dial faces and two high-quality Swiss watchworks in one watch.

Thomas Knauf Design (C2.322/421 C/D)

Making new jewelry pieces from old gold is nothing new. But the designers from Thomas Knauf are now offering a very new "recycling service". Ring blanks can be produced from old heirlooms using a specially designed molding machine. The material can be used 1:1 - something often desired due to the ideal reasons of relatives. This was previous a reason that many manufacturers rejected such orders or spent hours on the thankless task of improving a porous mold. The new technology has put an end to that.

Marion Knorr (C2.204/206 B Concepts Forum) / "wilde ehe ringe" (Sinful Wedding Rings)

"wilde ehe ringe" is the name of the collection from Marion Knorr for all those who like it conspicuous. The glowing red model "Lava" embodies fiery love, while golden tile look symbolizes security and protection. Rings made of several parts each contain an element of the counterpiece, a symbol of irreplaceable bonding. Handmade, unique pieces, which always belong together.

Lapponia Jewelry Oy (B2.100)/ RADIANT NEW APPEARANCE

Fascinating, feminine and original expressiveness: Lapponia has helped Finnish jewelry design succeed on the international scene with a unique language of shapes since the 60s. Two years after its merger with the long-established jewelry manufacturer Kalevala Koru Oy, Lapponia is presenting its relaunch with 35 new designs and the "Collection in Collection" concept. Engagement and wedding rings as well as the Space Silver Collection are also being presented new. Cooperation with the Finnish Opera Festival from Savonlinna is being announced with the appearance of the world-renowned opera baritone Tommi Hakala.

Leonardo (B2.216/218/321/323 B/C)

White and black are staying; color is coming. The Jewels by Leonardo designer Almute Cox selected this expressive formula for the current collection. Handicraft work is the focus from mouth-blown pearls to cat's eye stones, from Leonardo snaplinks all the way

to set stones and pearls. The fashionable world of color with bright, shimmering gray hues and anthracite, fiery red and lemon make jewelry shine. The Darlin's are cute, small pendants, which men or women can simply clip on to earrings, bracelets or necklaces. A snake and a winged couple made of stainless steel, which is adorned by a red pearl, are new. Leonardo also offers necklaces with black rings or white drop-shaped pearls as well as a matching Darlin.

Meister + Co.AG (B1.202) / Nature Characterizes the Meister Collection

Originality and the courage to express one's own personality characterize the new creations from Meister. The language of shapes is taken from nature, and the color stones have a special cut. This combination makes the jewelry pieces shine and be conspicuous. The "Girello" system is a highlight, in which two rings rotate around each other on the finest ball bearings. Meister is now also producing corresponding "Girello" pendants matching the finger rings. High-tech and ancient meet in a new line for men, in which the elements of titanium and damascene steel are combined to create rings, armllets, amulets and cufflinks. The white gold rings with black and white diamonds are an example for the timeless elegance of the wedding ring collection.

Morellato & Sector (A1.322/425) / First Jewelry Necklace Worldwide with MP3 Player

The first jewelry necklace worldwide with MP3 function is being presented by Morellato, the Italian company that manages a large design brand family (among others, Miss Sixty and Just Cavalli). Luxury and music are combined in three variants of the novel jewelry piece. Music fans can choose between a stainless steel model set with a diamond, a rosé gold creation in butterfly shape and a manly minimalist pendant with natural diamond. One gigabyte memory and a hidden headphone at the back of the neck round out the "Daily Chic". The eyecatcher was created for a special purpose; they serve as prizes for a contest at this year's film festival in Rome, of which the jewelry manufacturer is a partner. The USB stick has also become a fashionable accessory with the designs from Morellato. The company also puts special emphasis on affordable prices.

Beatrice Müller - Glanz und Gloria (C2.322/421 C/D Ph.Becker) / Wohlfühler (Feel Good) - A Ring, Which Exudes Emotions

To feel good, savor flowing, soft shapes, indulge in refined, luxurious materials: the ring "Wohlfühler" is an archetype for a new jewelry topic from "Glanz und Gloria" by Beatrice Müller. The ring shapes are soft and voluptuous, and polished surfaces underline with gracefulness. Platinum or gold with perceptible weight and set with tiny but wonderfully radiating diamonds, yellow sapphire, citrine and pearls. These are ornaments, which

seem like brocade tips on the precious metal!

Kirsten Plank (C2.235 B BKV) / Ear-Ring (Jewelry Set System)

Ear jewelry (clip, stud or pendant) and finger ring become one. The individual elements of the set combine in Ear-Ring to become a unified body. This jewelry packs itself; it can be transported easily when it is packed together, because sensitive parts (mechanic, pearls and jewelry stones) are protected in the inside. The Ear-Ring is a also tactile toy packed quickly into your pants pocket or handbag.

The ear jewelry-finger ring combination is produced in many models; shape, surface design, materials and colors vary.

International Platinum Guild (B1.314 C Platinum Forum) / Platinum Jewelry from 30 Manufacturers under the Auspices of the Platinum Guild

Magic and imagination set the most important jewelry trends of the Platinum Guild, at whose booth 30 manufacturers are exhibiting their novelties of platinum jewelry.

Many designers prefer this jewelry metal due to its symbolic power for new, extravagant wedding ring creations. Platinum is rare, pure and eternal. Designer Yuriy Gortikov transformed the current rediscovery of grandma's pearls in the young jewelry world into a platinum ring, in which pastel-colored pearls rest on diamond-set shells. An oval tourmaline sparkles green in the middle of diamonds on a platinum ring from Fillner and will especially attract all those enthusiastic about this upcoming fashionable color at inhorgenta.

Puma (A1.328/531 C/E)

Puma Time is providing freestyle and coolness on your wrist with watches, which are conspicuous with many details and rigorous shapes. The "Top Podium" line provides a lot of material and functions with a chronograph and an LCD. The design of the chronograph or 30s model "Top Gear" in racing look is relaxed and clean. The watch "Star Dust" shows off with a huge casing. Two stars rise behind mineral glass, of which one displays an hour and minutes and the other seconds. Ladies can find stardust in the form of a sparkling frame made of Swarovski stones.

Rauschmayer (B2.300)

An exclusively designed "Miss Germany Crown Ring" will shine on the finger of Germany's new beauty queen. Roland Rauschmayer is presenting the freshly crowned Miss Germany as well as current jewelry and wedding ring trends. The special Sandwich rings are completely new in the wedding ring collection this year. These bicolor rings

fascinate thanks to their novel production technology of processing materials layer-by-layer. They are produced from high-quality 14 and 18 carat gold. A special highlight is the new collection of partner and jewelry rings for her and him: the legendary "Eldino" ring made of 585 gold. Eldino jewelry means that three rings are linked with each other, but still move freely.

Claudia Rinneberg (C2.330 C Innovation Forum)

Claudia Rinneberg creates unique artworks from seemingly worthless materials. Her inspiration to create fire-molded surfaces and shapes comes from "old iron". Each of the respective impressions and expressions is found on the metal as well as on each piece made of silver and gold. As a result, every ring and every brooch becomes a unique piece: individual and unconventional, exactly like their wearer with all her rough edges.

Thomas Sabo (B1,116/118 A, B1,121 A)

The world is not enough for Thomas Sabo. The designer label is conquering higher spheres with its new Sterling silver collection "Take me higher". The outer-space jewelry, whose inspiration seems to come directly from an orbit, provides every outfit with a completely offbeat-elegant touch.

The world is turning, and Thomas Sabo is turning with it or back. The collection "East meets West" goes on a stylish trip through time to China of the 1920s and 1930s, where an extraordinary design symbiosis was created from Asian culture thousands of years old with the art deco era. The jewelry series "It-Girl on the beach" originated from a catwalk on the sandy beach of St. Tropez, while the collection "Desert Goddess" captures the magic moment of sunrise in the desert with radiating mother of pearl and shining smoky topaz.

Monika Seitter (C2.214/315 B/C Concepts Forum) / Radiating Collections The radiating collections of this designer are very varied and colorful. In series of rings made of artificial material, for example, she combines cultured South Sea pearls with colored stones, and shining precious stones spruce up her rock crystal and pearl necklaces in a fanciful way.

Ruth Sellack (C2.231 Aisle B) / New Collection in Fashionable Green and Blue Shades

The new collection is totally in the trend of the fashionable green and blue hues. Richly colored as well as subdued green-blue of the aquamarine shine mystically on rings and

earrings. In addition, Ruth Sellack is presenting her new diamond collection and specials such as her colorful, multi-row necklaces made of pearls, stones and brilliantly colored coral.

Eva Steinberg (C2.224 B Concepts Forum) / Colorful Gold-Enamel Jewelry

Colorful gold-enamel jewelry! The fashionable color green in many joyful turquoise shades runs through the collection from earrings to necklaces. The precise combining of innumerable, small fine gold leaves gives a few jewelry pieces a floral grace; they are combined with green stones or Tahiti pearls with a green shimmer, among other things.

Su Design (C2.330 A Innovation Forum)

Women are glad to become infected with this virus - the jewelry virus of the Dutch designer Su Kroker. The small "infectious agents" are unique, each one made by hand. They are composed in part of silk, copper or silver, crocheted with fine silver, enriched with glass beads, pearls, hematite or other pretty stones. They exist in many different shapes and almost seem like colorful flowers.

Stefanie von Scheven (C2.220 B Concepts Forum) / Flowery Rings

Elder and forget-me-not in casting resin bloom eternally on the rings of Stefanie von Scheven. As in a "Summer Night's Dream", a constellation sparkles composed of diamonds in a blue-colored sphere ring of the same name. In addition, she bets on the simple elegance of black and white in an eye-catching pearl pendant.

Schoeffel (B1,203/302 B/C)

The two luxury rings from the new line "Les Colibris" from Couture Collection of Schoeffel enchant like a airy flapping of wings. The mysterious, shimmering Tahiti pearls seem weightless in the middle of intensive, pink-colored sapphires in warm rosé gold. The prices are 8,200 euros (18 carat red gold) and 9,600 euros (18 carat white gold).

Dietmar Günster-von Schumann (C2.237 B)

Nature lovers will surely be enthusiastic about the tissue balls made of titanium, which Dietmar Günster-von Schumann is presenting at inhorgenta. The naturally colored and thermally dyed jewelry pieces made of pure titanium have diameters of 8 to 22 millimeters. Among others, there are bicolor combinations made of 900 yellow gold, 585 red gold and 950 palladium. The metal often used in medical technology and airplane construction light, anti-allergic and indestructible.

Claudia Schüller (C2.216 B Concepts Forum) / Individual Wedding Rings

Be an individual and still belong together: Claudia Schüller transformed this principle into the design of her wedding rings. A code text message can be engraved, which only makes sense when the two rings are put together: "For evermore!" The individual rings are as attractive as the whole.

Zobel Atelier, Inh. Peter Schmid (C2.324/423 C/D) / Calling, Coincidence, Fate

The new collection of the Zobel Studio is concentrating on stone fantasies of the Hochstrasser brothers from Schaffhausen. The highly gifted stone grinders are skilled at finding the right raw materials, recognizing their underlying properties and sealing their fates. The material complies obediently with the will of the brothers. They create extraordinary and imaginative shapes, which in turn inspire designers such as Michael Zobel and Peter Schmid.

A Hochstrasser stone influences the design concept, but it also has to submit to it. The unique jewelry pieces created by this seal the fate of the stones.
